







CLOSE TO HOME AND FULL OF FAMILY

For as long as Allison Lopez can remember, St. Anselm School has been like family.

It helps, of course, that the 13-year-old's father, uncles, cousins, and brother attended the school that has been proudly serving children in the South Bronx for more than a century. Her mother, Yahaira, has been a classroom aide at St. Anselm for 12 years – a few years before Allison first started Pre-K there.

"Some of us have had the same principal and the same teachers," Allison says of her family. "We talk about the experiences that we all share."

Among the stories they fondly remember is when Allison was a baby, the principal of the school held her much like an adoring mother or aunt and then watched her flourish at the school.

"St. Anselm is an amazing school," Allison says. "They are invested in our wellbeing and success."

That's why Allison, who receives the *Be A Student's Friend* Scholarship through Inner-City Scholarship Fund, feels safe, supported, and encouraged to grow academically, particularly in her favorite subject areas -- science and English Language Arts.

"Reading is my favorite," she says. "I like learning new vocabulary and reading fiction."

Her experiences at St. Anselm have been wonderful, she notes, and remain a common bond and conversation piece when the family is together. While the values, traditions, and uniforms have been a constant for generations, the school now uses laptops, smartboards, iPads, and other learning tools that weren't as prevalent generations before. These days there are far more activities, clubs, and sports than were offered to Allison's elders.

But there is a constant throughout the years: "It's home," Allison's mom, Yahaira says. "As soon as you walk through the doors, it's open and inviting."

The fact that Allison is graduating is bittersweet for their family. It's the end of a lovely chapter, and the beginning of another exciting one as Allison plans to continue her Catholic education in high school. Because of her experiences at St. Anselm, she knows she is ready for this next chapter.

MANY CHAPTERS, MANY LESSONS

When Kathy Bickart reflects on her tenure at St. Raymond Elementary School in the Bronx, she often pauses as she is flooded with a lifetime of memories. They go far beyond a traditional third grade teacher's experience.

You see, St. Raymond's has been a constant in Mrs. Bickart's -- and indeed her family's - life ever since she was a child. She started attending the school on East Tremont Avenue when she was 8 years old. After graduating eighth grade in the early 1990s, she returned to work at summer camps and after-school programs as a counselor throughout high school, and then as a substitute teacher.

It's also where her mother, Hilda Garcia, has worked for two decades. It's where her two sisters – Krystle and Karolann – attended. It's where her two nieces went to school. And now her daughter Juliana is learning the very same values in the very same classrooms.

The lessons have come full circle. "I always felt comfortable and welcome here," she says. "I had grown up with a lot of the people that worked here." Returning made a lot of sense because it felt like home.

"Something pulled me back," she says. "It is the people. It is the community here. We really care about the children. It's like a family."

Mrs. Bickart appreciates that the values the school espoused when she was young have remained the same. Kindness. Respect. And a faith-based education. The students care for each other like a family and embrace each other's differences, she notes.

"They have to care about each other and help each other while being respectful to the person next to you," she says. "I learned that when I was a kid, and now I'm teaching it."





When Margo and Carrol Muccia Jr. encouraged their children, Tim, David, Elizabeth and Anne to be involved with charities affiliated with Catholic schools in the Archdiocese of New York, they needed little convincing of the transformative power of a Catholic education.

"Growing up, we were always taught to give back - of our time, resources, and in any way that we could," Tim says. "Our parents led by example and education was always a focus for them."

While they are active with many nonprofits and Catholic schools throughout the Archdiocese, the proof of success with Inner-City Scholarship Fund was seeing the impact on children's lives, the brothers noted.

"The model absolutely works," Tim says. "The numbers speak for themselves in terms of efficacy and success. There is an excellent return on investment."

In his experiences working with Catholic schools, David saw first hand the influence a principal, teacher, and parish priest could have on a student, particularly ones living in challenging neighborhoods. "The impact on students was evident," he says. "It was incredible to see."

The values-based education is in fact time-tested, and the curriculum is future-focused.



Students in the Archdiocese of New York consistently outperform their peers in New York's ELA and math exams, and 99 percent of high school seniors graduate and 98 percent of those students are accepted to college or post-secondary education, according to recent figures.

The numbers are even more impressive when you consider that many families face a myriad of other challenges such as economic hardship, food insecurity, and the like.

"The schools are a real oasis for the children," David says.

That's why the Muccias have made supporting Inner-City Scholarship Fund a family affair. It began when parents Margo and Carrol first got involved in 1995.

Tim then joined the Board of Trustees in 2011 and David has been the chair of the Westchester Dinner for Catholic Schools. The Muccia brothers, along with their sisters Anne Droesch and Elizabeth Pyle, remain avid supporters of Catholic education.

They are also making sure their children — the next generation of volunteers and supporters — understand the importance of Inner-City's mission and work.

"They are seeing firsthand the good work that is being done through Inner-City Scholarship Fund," David says.




